



LayTec's ftp-site: **ftp.laytec.de**

1 General purpose

As a special service, LayTec is providing an ftp-server to ease exchange of large files between LayTec and our customers all over the world.

The ftp-server should be used in the following situations:

- A customer wants to send data files to LayTec, that are way too big for an email attachment (such as EpiR DA colorplots or EpiTT raw data dumps). If the files to be transferred are bigger than 5 MB we strongly encourage our customers to upload the files onto our ftp site instead of sending them by email.
- LayTec needs to supply a software update that exceeds the mailbox limit of the recipient and that is not available for download on the support page of LayTec's web-site (<http://www.laytec.de>).

2 How to use the ftp site

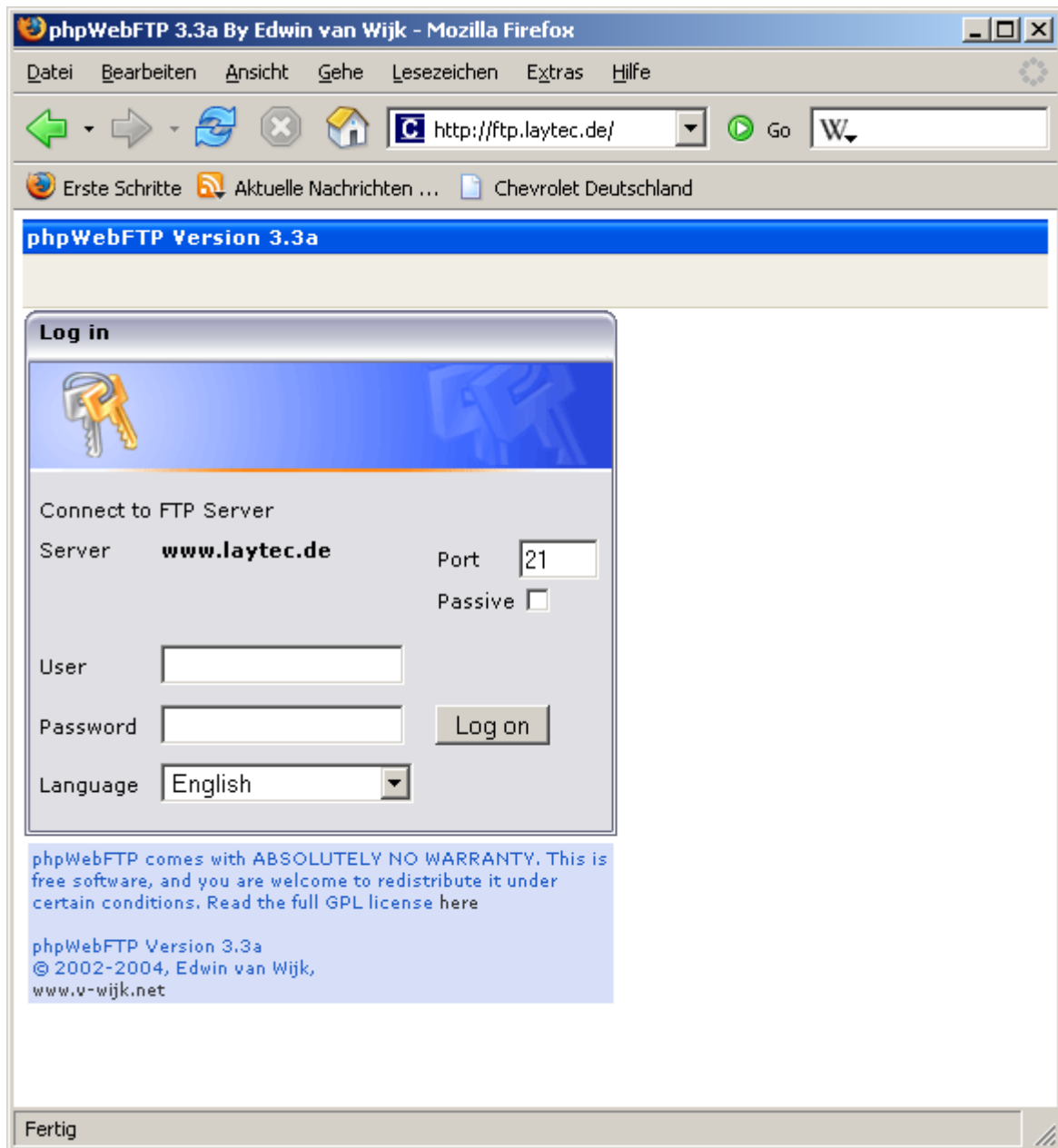
To access the ftp site, simply use any web browser and enter the address:

<http://ftp.laytec.de>

You will be prompted to enter a user ID and a password. (Please use your own User ID and your customer password or contact support@laytec.de to obtain them.)

If you cannot log on, it is most probable that your ftp-client tries to log on as "anonymous". In this case, please change the settings of your ftp-client so that you are prompted for a user name. See the Appendix how to do this for Microsoft Internet Explorer.

If you want to connect via a standard ftp-client or with "total commander", please use the following address: **<http://www.laytec.de>**

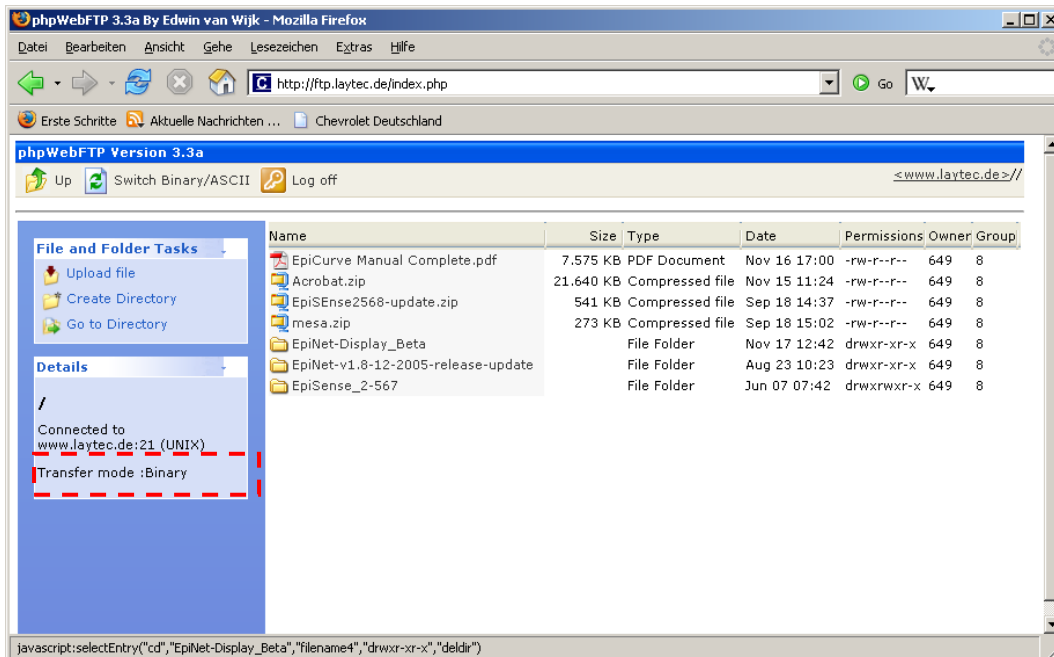
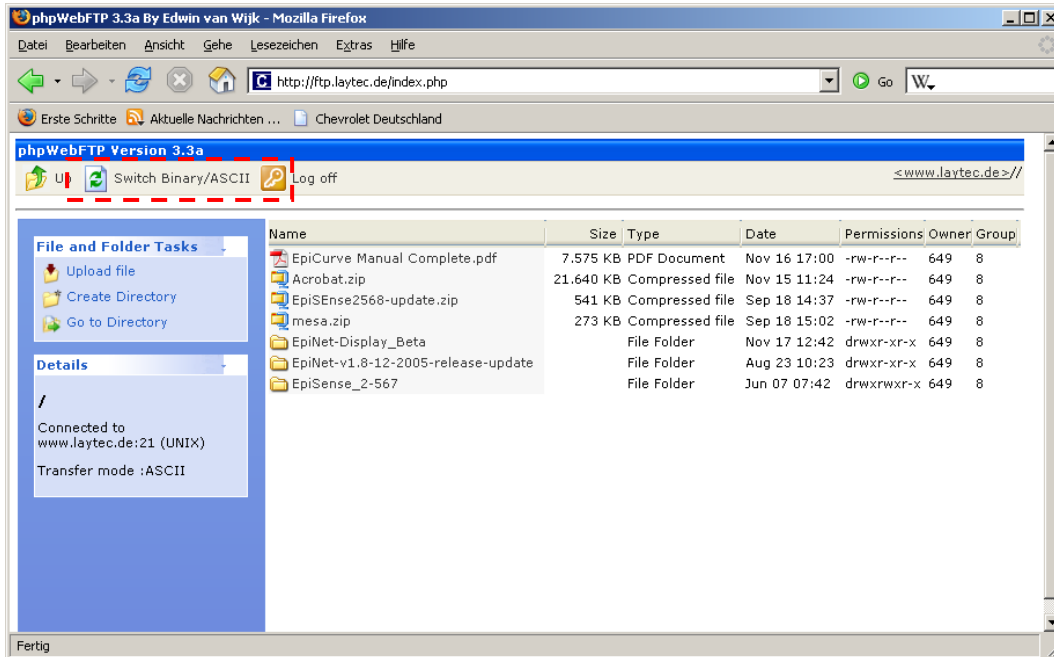


3 Directions for uploading files onto the ftp-server

- big data files (ASCII) should be zipped to make the upload (and download) process quicker
- please create a new folder before uploading files; its best to name the folder according to the serial number of your LayTec tool (such as: EpiTT 2004-50)
- If the data contain confidential or proprietary information, we strongly suggest to zip the files and to use a password protection for the archive.



- after uploading the files please inform LayTec by email (either inform your personal contact or send an email to support@laytec.de). If the zip-files are password protected, please include the password in the email. LayTec will immediately remove the files from the ftp-site after receiving the email.
- Please switch to **BINARY** mode prior to upload files





4 Directions for downloading files from the ftp-server

- If LayTec supplies an update for you on the ftp-site, you will be notified by email when the files are uploaded.
- After downloading the files please inform LayTec by email. As space on the server is limited, we will remove the files after successful download.
- Please switch to **BINARY** mode prior to download files
- Please use the “zip & download” button to download complete directories. To download **single files**, just **double click** on the file name.

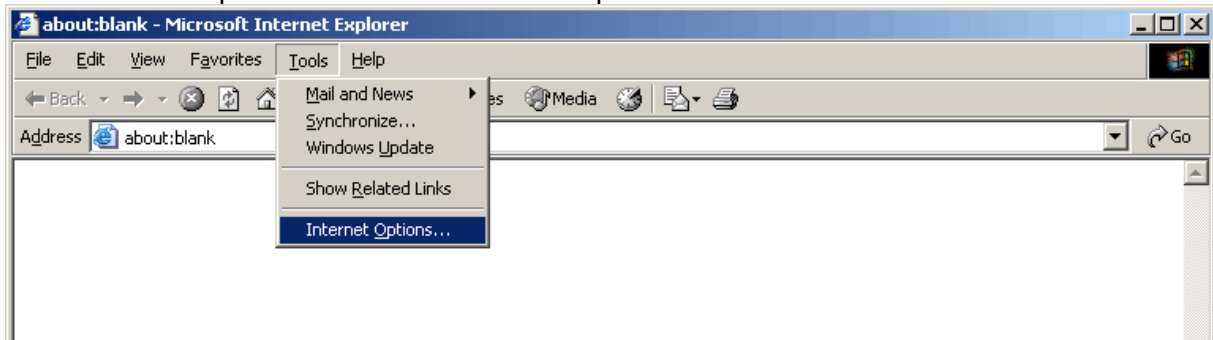

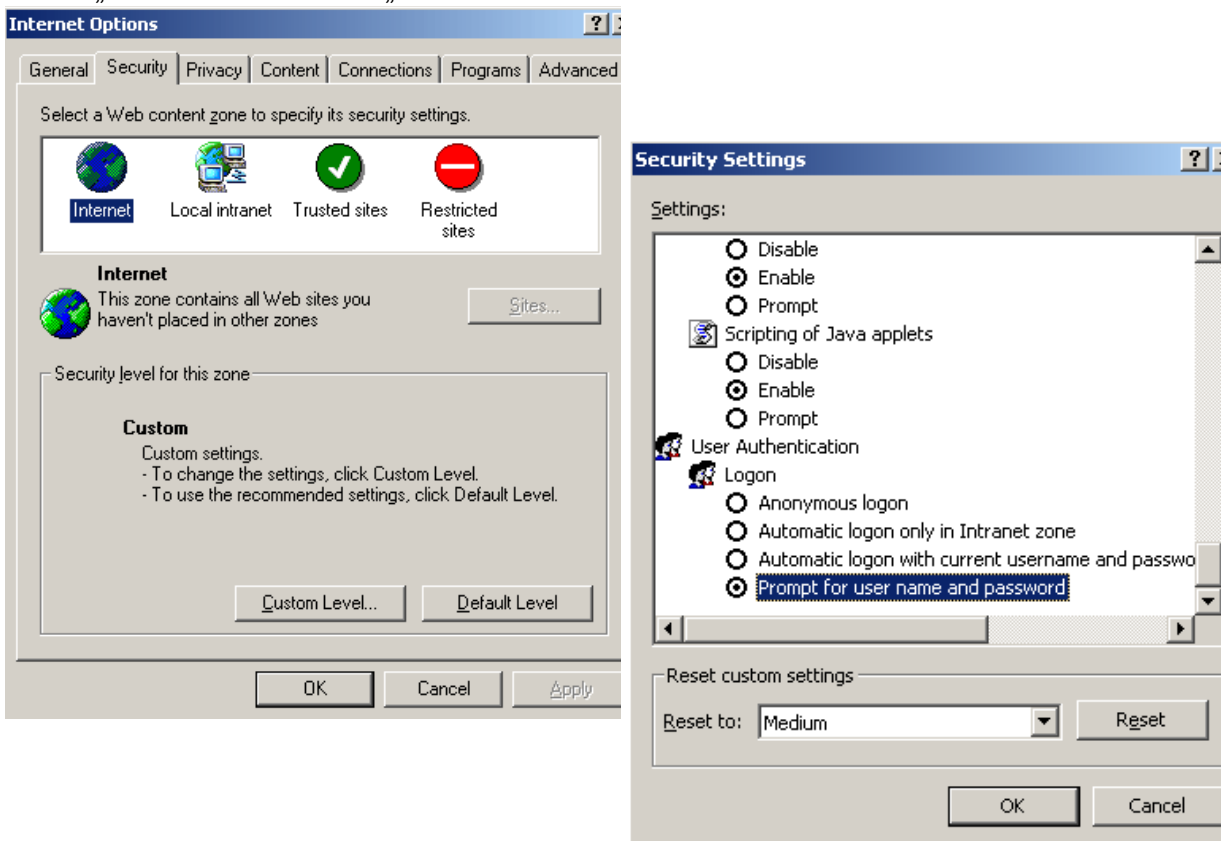
Appendix

How to configure Internet Explorer to prompt for user name and password

Run "Internet Explorer" and chose "Internet Options" from the "Tools" menu.



Select „Internet“ and click on „Custom Level ...“



Look for „User Authentication“ and enable “Prompt for user name and password”. Finally click “OK”.
